

There will be an informal Anishnabe ceremony on Jan 6-7, 2008 in the area north of the English River Traditional Territory of Asubpeeschoseewagong to draw upon our Ancestors and spirits who roamed freely upon these lands and forests to help us in our fight to protect these lands and forests for ourselves and future generations forever and to stay focussed in our fight and not to allow money and processes to divert and distort our focus. Also to drive home the point that any outcome must be based

on one of the most sacred and important laws of the Traditional Anishnabe Laws is **full**

consensus and in the interests of everyone and future generations to come forever. Any outcome must have go through the traditional governments that presently prevail over the Asubpeeschoseewagong Territory not restricted by the Indian Act.

Our persistence has brought our fight to a place where our own Traditional Ancestral laws might once again eventually prevail over our own People and Territory.
